Webby Cup Purpose

To foster and further develop relationships between the participating members of these two branches in Ontario.
To network, to share information and best practices.

Date and Time:

Eligibility:

- Team Members **MUST** be a Professional Member of their CMAC Branch.
- Any Male or Female Members are eligible.
- Team Members **MUST** have a current established handicap index.
- 12 persons from each branch selected as follows:
 - Branch President
 - Webby Cup Event Chairperson
 - Webby Cup Event 1st Vice Chairperson
 - Host Club General Manager
 - Up to 8 additional players selected by random draw from all entrants that meet the event criteria
 - (9 players for the visiting team)

Format:

- 18 Hole, Net Best Ball (Match Play)
 - Two players from each team play their own ball, the lowest net score for the team is the final score.
 - The lowest score wins the hole.
 - Handicaps of the players in each foursome will be reduced by the lowest handicap of the group, the remaining players receive 100% of the difference.
 - Strokes will be allocated by the stroke holes as noted on the scorecard.
 - The tees played will be those that are closest to 6400 yards for the men or 5200 yards for the ladies.
 - Scoring as follows:
 - Each foursome match is worth 18 points
 - An outright win of the hole receives 1 point
 - If the teams tie, they receive ½ point each for that hole.
 - There are no bonus points for winning the most holes.

The results from each match played will be added together, the team with the most overall points wins the competition.
